Cooking wall



Door, then sink to its right



The look you asked for



Green square tile

Small glossy squares, varied green shades and a handmade surface, following your inspiration photo.

Warm brown stained wood

Match the doors, frames, exposed side panels and retained wood niches to the inspiration's warm wood tone.

The wooden niches beside the stove stay.

Option 01 / Light gray



THE COUNTERTOP

Cloudy pale gray with gentle darker movement.

A lighter, softer contrast with the green tile and warm wood.

Polished finish
Simple eased edge
1 1/4-inch nominal (3 cm)

A 2-inch built-up edge can also be viewed in the phone presentation.

Option 02 / Warm ash gray



THE COUNTERTOP

Warm gray with a quiet, fine-speckled pattern.

A warm, balanced gray alongside the brown cabinetry.

Polished finish
Simple eased edge
1¼-inch nominal (3 cm)

A 2-inch built-up edge can also be viewed in the phone presentation.

Option 03 / Medium gray



THE COUNTERTOP

Flowing lighter and darker gray movement.

A deeper gray that gives the countertop more presence.

Polished finish
Simple eased edge
1¼-inch nominal (3 cm)

A 2-inch built-up edge can also be viewed in the phone presentation.

Proposed renovation scope

Area	Proposed change
Countertops	Gray polished surface · 1¼-inch nominal or 2-inch built-up edge
Backsplash	Glossy green square tile · optional tile around the window
Cabinet work	Two new left end panels, warm stain and new knobs
Stove and hood	Wolf stove and exposed stainless hood; center wood removed
Wood niches	Keep both narrow wooden niches beside the stove
Cabinet glass	Replace beveled glass with flat, clear panes
Sink and faucet	Stainless undermount sink and a new pull-down faucet
Wood floor	Keep the existing flooring, color, plank widths and direction
Cabinet function	Repair trash pullout and review all door hinges

The layout stays true to your kitchen



90-degree corner

The stove wall turns to the door and sink wall.

Sink right of the door

The door opening remains clear between the counters.

Original wood floor

Keep the current brown floor, plank widths and direction.

Room proportions are illustrative.
Final dimensions are field verified.

A real stainless hood

Remove the large wooden center enclosure and install an exposed metal hood.

The wood niches stay

Retain and stain both wooden niches beside the green backsplash.

36-inch stove · 42-inch hood

Two new left cabinet end panels



Upper left cabinet

A new decorative panel on the exposed upper cabinet side.

Lower left cabinet

A new matching panel below the countertop, with a finished toe-kick detail.

Matching warm brown stain
Flat clear cabinet glass
New satin nickel hardware

Cabinet hardware and function

Detail	Proposed work	Before ordering
Knobs and pulls	New satin nickel door knobs and coordinated drawer pulls	Approve style and quantity. Measure existing hole spacing.
Door hinges	Review full replacement with compatible soft-close hinges	Check hinge cups, door overlap and opening clearance.
Trash pullout	Repair rack, runners and door alignment	Inspect mechanism and confirm any replacement parts.
Cabinet glass	Replace beveled panes with flat clear glass	Measure each existing glass opening.

Cabinet frames and door profiles remain the basis of the design.

A clean countertop-to-sink edge



A smooth working surface

The sink mounts beneath the counter, leaving no raised rim above the gray surface.

A new pull-down faucet

A matching stainless finish and high arc complete the sink area.

Choose the countertop edge

1¼-inch nominal edge



Standard 3 cm slab with a simple eased edge.

2-inch built-up edge



A deeper mitered or built-up edge. Subject to availability and fabrication confirmation.

Would you like the tile around the window?

A / Lower backsplash



Tile below the window, with the painted wall visible above.

B / Around the window



Continue the green tile up the sides and above the window. Keep the wood trim.

Choose your finish

Option	Countertop direction
Option 01	Light gray — Cloudy pale gray with gentle darker movement.
Option 02	Warm ash gray — Warm gray with a quiet, fine-speckled pattern.
Option 03	Medium gray — Flowing lighter and darker gray movement.

Next step

Choose your gray, edge and backsplash height.
Review the tile, wood stain and hardware together.
Send us any questions or changes you have in mind.

Project feasibility checks

Stone and edge

Confirm the selected gray, available slab thickness and feasibility of the optional 2-inch built-up edge.

Cabinets and hardware

Confirm both new end panels, hardware quantities, compatible hinges and the trash pullout repair.

Installation details

Verify countertop templates, appliance fit, ventilation, sink cutout and plumbing connections.
